WARM WEATHER DRESS: With the weather warming up, please remember the following:

~ Spaghetti straps and tank tops are not permitted. Sleeveless tops must be three inches on the shoulder.

~ Shorts must be hemmed, clean and neat. They may be no shorter than mid-thigh. The best way to judge this is to have your child stand with their arms hanging straight at their sides. The shorts should be no shorter than the fingertips.

~ No flip flop, sandals or open toed shoes.

~ Shirts must be long enough to cover the waistband of the student's shorts, skirt or pants when their arms are fully extended above their heads. No low neck or back lines.
