MAIN PARKING LOT, DROP OFF AND PICK UP REMINDERS:
Safety is always our priority in the parking lot!

- Pull your car up in front of the Worship Center so that your student can use the steps to enter or leave campus.
- After school, do not park in the pick up line before classes are outside. Wait until all students are in place before entering the line. If you are here early, park to the side so others may drive through the parking lot.
- No talking on cell phones while in the drop off and pick up line.

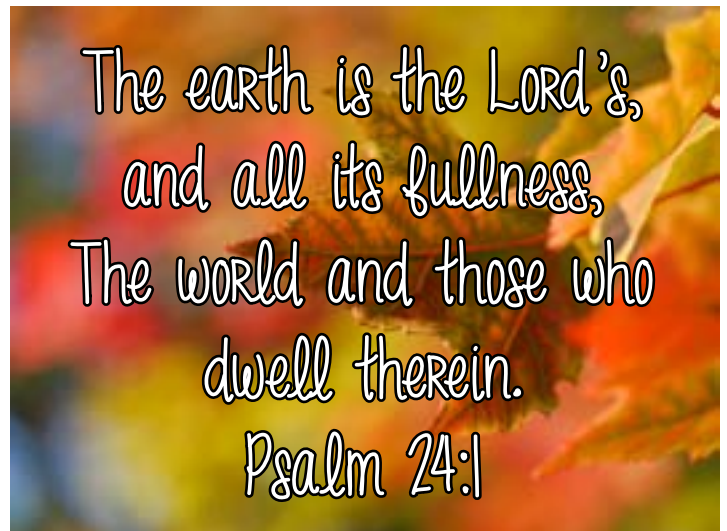
EARLY PICK UP: If you need to pick your child up during the day before school is out for an appointment, the procedure is as follows:

- Send a note to your child's teacher indicating the time they will be leaving. This will help the teacher to remind the student to be prepared for your arrival.
- Allow yourself extra time to come into the school office to sign your child out.
- The office staff will call for your child when you arrive. We do not call for students before you get to the school.

ALL ABSENCES: Thank you CCS families for **contacting the office by phone or email after 9:00 a.m. letting us know when your child is absent.** If your child has any of the following symptoms, they must stay home from school.

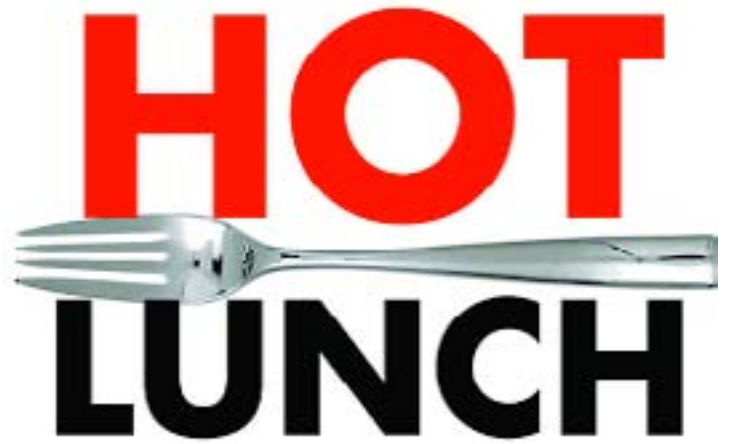
- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

SNACKS: Send a few healthy snacks with your child so they can refuel during their morning and afternoon breaks. High protein foods are a great choice such as cheese sticks, crackers and peanut butter, yogurt, popcorn, celery with peanut butter and raisins, nuts, trail mix, hard boiled egg, apples and peanut butter, etc.
