**WARM WEATHER DRESS:** With the weather warming up, please remember the following:

~ Spaghetti straps and tank tops are not permitted. Sleeveless shirts and tops must be a width of 3 inches on the shoulder.

~ Shorts must be hemmed, clean and neat. They may be no shorter than mid-thigh. Judge this by letting your arms relax at your side. The shorts should be no shorter than where your fingertips are on the thigh.

~ No flip flop, sandals or open toed shoes.

~ Shirts must be long enough to cover the waistband of the students; shorts, skirt or pants when their arms are fully extended above their heads. No low neck or back lines.

**SCHOOL START TIME:** Please remember, students should be in the classroom and ready to start their day at 8:30 a.m. If your child arrives after 8:30 a.m., they will need to go to the office to get a tardy slip to be admitted to class. Teachers will shut their doors promptly at 8:30 a.m. We suggest you arrive to school by 8:25 a.m.
